Varna (Sanskrit: वर्ण, romanized: varṇa) means type, order, colour or class. The term refers to social classes in Dharma-shastra books like the Manusmriti. These and other Hindu literature classified the society in principle into four varnas: Brahmins: priests, scholars and teachers.; Kshatriyas: rulers, warriors and administrators.; Vaishyas: agriculturalists and traders.

The caste system is technically illegal but widely practiced (generally more in rural areas). The Hindu social division system comprises four major categories (varnas) that are found India-wide but are often subdivided into hundreds of sub-categories (jatis), many of which are often found only in specific areas.
